- Please help us stay current by notifying the office if your contact information has changed.

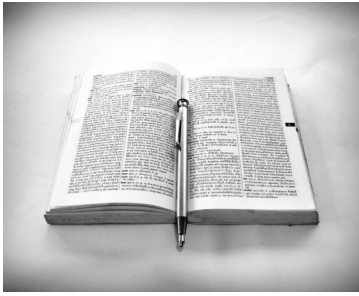
Office Closed: The church office will be closed on Easter Monday, **April 21**.
